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ADVANCED CAMP: July 20-24 from 2-6 pm

- **Fees:** \$150 for early registration AND payment through April 30; \$200 afterwards; full scholarship for those students who receive free or reduced lunch; includes camp t-shirt

INTERMEDIATE CAMP: July 27-31 from 9 am-1 pm OR 2-6 pm (sign up for ONE session)

- Priority for afternoon session for students attending Troy's science camp
- Next priority to Troy HS students or incoming Troy HS 9th graders
- **Fees:** \$150 for early registration AND payment through April 30; \$200 afterwards; full scholarship for those students who receive free or reduced lunch; includes camp t-shirt
- **Prerequisites:** Open to any high school or middle school students with:
 - High school: one year of CyberPatriot but did not make the Platinum tier in high school
 - Middle school: 1 year of middle school cyber and competed in the semi-final round
- **Camp goals:**
 - Training in Windows 10, Windows Server 16, Ubuntu 14, Ubuntu 16

BEGINNER CAMP: July 27-31 from 9 am-1 pm OR 2-6 pm (sign up for ONE session)

- **Enrollment cap:** 120 per session
 - Priority to students attending or incoming 9th graders to Troy HS
 - Priority for afternoon session for students attending Troy's science camp
 - Open to any high school or middle school students
- **Fees:** \$150 early for registration AND payment through April 30; \$200 afterwards; full scholarship for those students who receive free or reduced lunch
- **Prerequisites:** None. No experience of any kind is needed.
- **Camp goals:**
 - Introduce students to cybersecurity including Windows 10 and Ubuntu 16
 - Provide a supportive environment for females to try cybersecurity
 - 3 hour competition on Friday; camp t-shirts will be issued on the first day.

ELEMENTARY CAMP (grades 4-5): July 28-29 from 9 am-1 pm OR 2-6 pm (sign up for ONE session)

- Open to any students going into grades 4-5. No experience of any kind is needed.
- **Fees:** \$60 for early registration AND payment through April 30; \$75 afterwards; full scholarship for those students who receive free or reduced lunch
- **Camp goals:** Introduce students to safe computing practices, explaining WiFi basics, and short session on the Internet of Things. Will use a combination of games and interactive activities
- Camp t-shirts will be issued on the first day.

ELEMENTARY CAMP (grades 1-3): July 30 from 9 am-1 pm OR 2-6 pm (sign up for ONE session)

- Open to any students going into grades 1-3. No experience of any kind is needed.
- **Fees:** \$30 for early registration AND payment through April 30; \$40 afterwards; full scholarship for those students who receive free or reduced lunch
- **Camp goals:**
 - Introduce students to safe computing practices, explaining good passwords, and the building blocks of cybersecurity on a network
 - Will use a combination of games and interactive activities
 - Session will finish with popcorn reading of *Sarah the Cyber Hero*
- Camp t-shirts and copy of *Sarah the Cyber Hero* will be issued at check-in

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
